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fact it is not yet ready for a recommendation. Regarding the land use and zoning change proposals, a decision was made to review each on its own to offer a recommendation since there was not a consensus to approve them together. Lastly, the development code amendments were discussed including revisions suggested by members such as the use of renaming river rock to "natural appearing stones", electric vehicles parking, and naming LID instead of using the word "alternative".

MOTION: Commissioner Hansen moved to recommend no change to the Grand Mound Urban Growth Area, and make no change to the land use and associated zoning of the Deskin and Black Lake Quarry properties. Commissioner Nelson seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

MOTION: Commissioner Hansen moved to recommend approval of land use and rezoning amendment changes for Fire District #14, Tribal Trust Lands and Morgan, and an amendment to Thurston County Code Chapters 20.15, 20.21A, 20.25, 20.27, 20.28, 20.36, 20.40, 20.44, and 20.45, and incorporate Grand Mound Design Guidelines and lot width standards with recommended changes. Move to recommend no change for the land use and zoning amendment changes for Jackson & Singh. Commissioner Simmons seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

MOTION: <u>Commissioner Hansen moved to recommend approval of land use and the associated zoning for the Steelhammer property. Commissioner Simmons seconded.</u>
<u>Motion carried 6 yays and 2 nays.</u>

Staff will return in the new year to discuss the Wilmovsky property and draft Subarea Plan.
