6.72.010 Definitions.



As used in this chapter the words in this section shall have the following meanings indicated, unless the context clearly requires otherwise:

Α.

"Appliances" means new radios, television sets, washing machines, refrigerators, toasters, food mixers, waffle irons and similar items commonly sold in retail jewelry stores.

B.

"Auction" means the sale of jewelry and appliances at either private or public sale, upon oral or written bids, to the highest bidder, and shall include all such sales although denominated as "action" sales or by any similar words.

C.

"Jewelry" includes new gold, silver, plated ware, precious or semiprecious stones, mounted or unmounted, watches, clocks and goods, wares and merchandise commonly classified as jewelry and commonly offered for sale in jewelry stores.

6.72.020 License required.

It is unlawful to sell, offer for sale, or attempt to sell at auction anywhere in Thurston County, any jewelry or appliances unless a license has been obtained from Thurston County.

6.72.030 Applicability of provisions.

This chapter shall not apply to judicial sales or government sales, or sales by an executor, administrator, guardian, receiver, or trustee in bankruptcy so authorized by any court of competent jurisdiction.

6.72.040 License—Application—Fee—Bond.

Application for a license shall be made to the Thurston County auditor. The fee for each license shall be two hundred and fifty dollars. Each applicant shall also file a bond in an amount equal to one-half of the cost value of the articles inventoried for sale.

6.72.050 Additional requirements and regulations.

In addition to the requirements of this chapter, all persons must meet the requirements of Chapter 18.12 RCW, and any rules and regulations adopted pursuant to such chapter.
