Mason Transit provides service between Shelton and Olympia, and Grays Harbor Transit provides service between its major cities and Olympia.

Intercity Transit provides express service between Olympia/Lacey and Lakewood/Tacoma. Service to Seattle is provided in cooperation with Sound Transit.

Intercity Transit provides door-to-door, complementary paratransit service in compliance with the provisions of the Americans with Disabilities Act. This service is provided up to ¾ mile of a fixed-route in the Lacey, Olympia and Tumwater areas and up to 1½ miles of the Centennial Station/Downtown Yelm Route.

Rural & Tribal Transportation provides door-to-door, complementary paratransit service within ¾ mile of a fixed route, in compliance with provisions of the Americans with Disabilities Act.
