RCW/Code: Article IV, Section 16

This policy applies to onsite sewage systems (OSS) that the annual renewals of their operational certificates (OPC).

- 1. <u>Inspections, of OSSs that are required to Nave an applically renewed OPC, must be done no earlier than 90 days prior to the OPS expiral or date when the inspection is done for the purposes of renewing the OPC.</u>
- 2. Reports of inspections completed more than 30 days prior to the OPC expiration date will be considered too old to reflect the status of the OSS for the purposes of issuing an OPC, and will not be accepted by the department.
- 3. All OSS professionals must submit inspection reports to the Health Officer by the 10th of the month following the data inspected using onlineRME system.
