<u>Description of Proposal</u>: The proposal is for a Thurston County ordinance amending and adding an article to the

Sanitary Code for Thurston County. The proposed code amendment would enact a new Article VIII of the Sanitary Code for Thurston County, effective January 1, 2021, to prohibit smoking and vaping in indoor public places, places of employment, and certain youth-oriented outdoor public places; require signs to be posted where smoking and vaping are

prohibited; and establish provisions to administer and enforce the article.

Because the proposed code amendments are not associated with a specific development proposal or site-based project, they are being reviewed as a Non-project Action, in accordance with the requirements of the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA).
