Recall Alert: Saline and Sterile Water Medical Products

The U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) recently issued a <u>Safety Communication</u> warning consumers, health care providers, and health care facilities not to use recalled saline (0.9% sodium chloride) and sterile water medical products manufactured by Nurse Assist, LLC. The potentially contaminated products are sold under various brands and include a wide range of product types with expiration dates that extend to 2025 and beyond.

The U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) also issued a <u>Safety Communication</u> notifying that "Cardinal Health issued a medical device recall on December 5, 2023, for its Covidien and Cardinal HealthTM brand urology and operating room-specific kits and trays that contain 0.9% sodium chloride irrigation USP and sterile water for irrigation USP supplied by Nurse Assist."

Action Requested:

- Assure timely and effective removal of these products
- Track patient exposures to recalled saline and sterile water products as part of your response activities
- Reports of Hospital Acquired Infections associated with use of these recalled products can be transmitted via <u>MedWatch</u>.
