TC Alert is Thurston County's primary alert and notification system for notifying residents of emergencies or hazards. These types of notifications typically target a geographic area and include a wide range of alerts, such as burn bans, boil notices, missing persons, and chemical spills. The system is activated when Emergency Management believes residents need a heightened level of warning to protect life or property.

Residents can choose to receive texts, phone calls, or email messages, and the types of notification they would like to receive, all based on their preference.

Thurston County's winter clothing drive is now collecting donations! Now is a great time to clean out your closets and donate warm clothing items you no longer need. Doing holiday shopping? Pick up an extra package of wool socks to donate. Donate new or gently used clothing items like winter jackets, pants, shirts, sweaters, sweatshirts, gloves, hats, and scarves. All sizes for adults and kids welcome. Adult sizes Med-XXL are most needed.

Donations are collected every Friday from 1 p.m. -3 p.m. at the Old Olympia Fire Hall at 108 State Avenue NW in downtown Olympia. Please use the parking lot side door across from the Olympia Senior Center. The items will be distributed to our homeless neighbors as part of the annual Point in Time Count. The Point in Time Count is a census event where partners of the Thurston County Homeless Crisis Response System and community volunteers conduct a count the unsheltered individuals living in county.

Thurston County Emergency Management is seeking individuals living or working along area rivers to become part of our River Spotter Program.

#### Why River Spotters?

- River gauges often do not accurately reflect a river's conditions upstream and downstream due to changes in the river's course, sediment, or debris such as fallen trees.
- The best way to know how the river's flow corresponds to the gauges is from visual observation.

#### **River Spotter Requirements**

- Willingness to safely observe nearby river conditions quarterly, and more often during flood events.
- Ability to send a photo with a short report of locations, date, and time.

Thurston County


