

Stormwater Planning Subcommittee Recommendations

The Stormwater Planning Subcommittee what the SSWAB had identified as objectives at the retreat.

1. Expand performance measures for tracking progress of the stormwater program. This would require an evaluation of those parameters already being measured, and what could be easily tracked by staff. Examples could include, but not be limited to:
 - Numbers of business inspections, potentially follow up actions to bring business into compliance
 - Numbers of outfalls without flow controls
 - Numbers of outfalls with treatments controls per standards
 - Monitoring stations and those with violations for water quality parameters.
2. Propose a stormwater monitoring plan for 3 outfalls to assess concentrations of dissolved metals, PFAs/PFOAs, and 6 PPD (pollutant associated with tire dust). The proposal would require the subcommittee to evaluate locations of the outfalls to be monitored, numbers of times per year the stormwater should be monitored, costs of monitoring including cost of hiring a contractor to conduct the monitoring.
3. Increase the number of treated outfalls by 10% per year.
