ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER PERMITTING SUBMISSION OF ADMINISTRATIVE RECORDS ON USB FLASH DRIVES

Thurston County Superior Court Local Court Rule (LCR) 79(i)(8) provides that administrative records shall be submitted in hard copy and on CD "[u]nless the court orders otherwise." Many administrative agencies request that they be allowed to provide administrative records on a USB flash drive rather than CD because they do not have the ability to create CDs and USB flash drives are more durable and secure.

USB flash drives are a reasonable alternative to CDs. The Court finds that issuance of this standing order is more efficient than issuance of orders on a case-by-case basis. Therefore, it is appropriate to exercise the authority reserved in LCR 79(i)(8) to issue this Order permitting the use of USB flash drives for the submission of administrative records.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT administrative records covered by LCR 79(i)(8) may be submitted in hard copy and on either CD or USB flash drive. This order shall expire on September 1, 2024.
