I would like to express my support for the planned improvements and activities at Capitol Land Trust's Inspiring Kids Preserve (IKP) located at 4849 Johnson Point Road NE, Olympia, WA 98516.

In North Thurston Public Schools, we prioritize hands-on, field-based science that includes habitat and adaptations study, water quality testing, climate literacy, first-hand experience with local environmental issues, and service-learning restoration activities. Engaging students in both meaningful and "real" science that is making a difference in their local Puget Sound watershed connects our students' in-class learning with real-life and locally relevant issues resulting in increased engagement both in school and their community. This wouldn't be possible without access to ecologically significant natural spaces.
