

Report in Brief: Thurston County Sales Tax Revenue



February sales tax revenue totaled \$2,458,600.20.

Compared to February 2022, year-over-year growth was 8.4%, with a total increase if \$190,563.66.

February sales tax is earned during the month of December.

Total sales tax accumulation year-over-year growth for February was 8.4%.

Retail Trade made up approximately 48% of the total revenue received from sales tax. Year-over-year growth for Retail Trade was strong at 20% for an increase of \$196,542. It is normal to see a sharp spike in February due to holiday shopping.

Revenue from Construction accounted for 19% of the total sales tax revenue. Year-over-year growth for construction was down at -8% coming in \$41,759 lower.

Accommodation & Food Services was down 23% compared to February 2022, however this category experienced an unusual spike in revenue in 2022. Accommodation & Food Services on average, is the 3rd highest revenue category for sales tax. This month it was the 5th highest accounting for 5% of total revenue.
