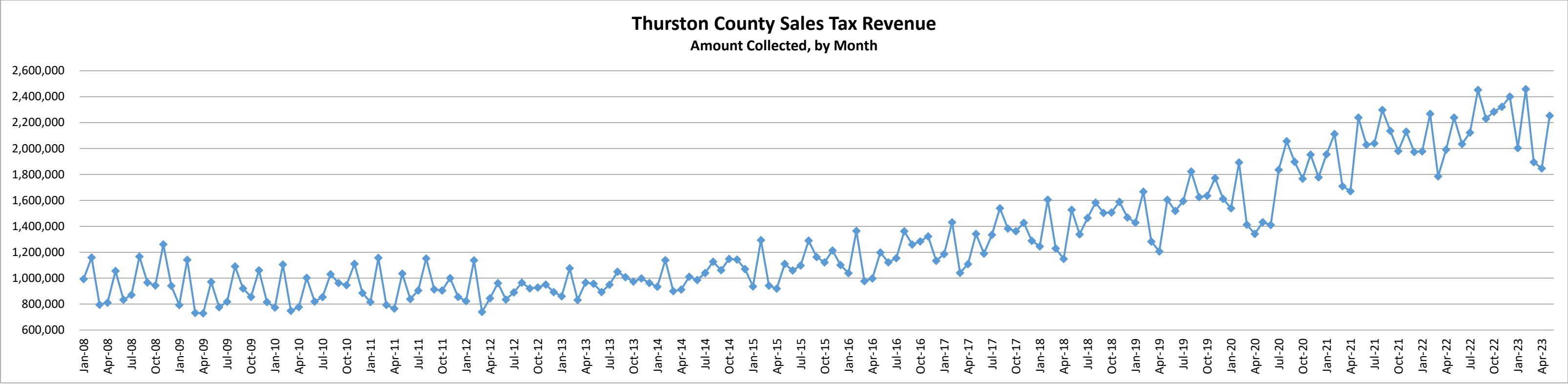


May sales tax revenue totaled \$2,253,109.79.

Compared to May2022, year-over-year growth was flat at .64%.

May sales tax is earned during the month of March.

Year over Year growth for 2023 so far is 1.9%.

Total sales tax accumulation year-over-year growth for May was .64%.

Retail Trade made up approximately 41% of the total revenue received from sales tax. Year-over-year growth for Retail Trade was down 8.61%, coming in \$88,393 less. Despite negative year-over year growth, the overall trend line is continuing its normal pattern.

Revenue from Construction accounted for 20% of the total sales tax revenue. Year-over-year growth for construction was strong at 18%.
