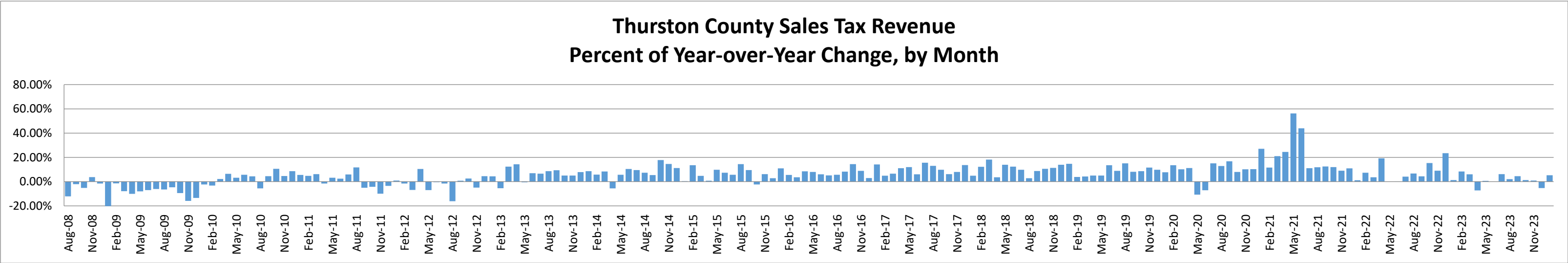
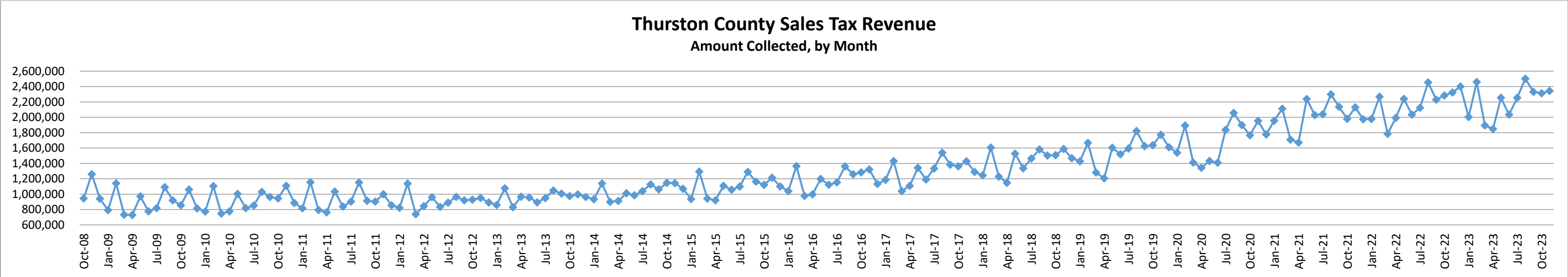


Report in Brief: Thurston County Sales Tax Revenue



January sales tax revenue totaled 2,116,695.91.
Compared to January 2023, year-over-year growth was 5.30%.
January sales tax is earned during the month of November.
Year over Year growth for 2024 is approximately 5.30%.

Total sales tax accumulation year-over-year (YOY) growth for January was 5.30%.

Retail Trade made up approximately 51% of the total revenue received from sales tax. The majority of the decrease in revenue came from Construction which was down \$209,833 from 2023 and Accommodation & Food Services which was down \$93,471 from 2023.

Revenue from Wholesale Trade accounted for 9.38% of the total sales tax revenue.

Accommodation and Food Services accounted for just 0.89% of the total sales tax revenue.

Except for Construction, Thurston County followed similar trends to the overall sales tax accumulation in Washington State.
