

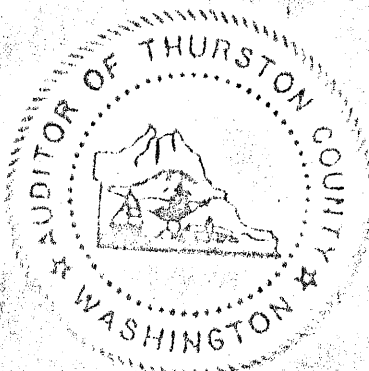



Explanation of the discrepancies and/or the process followed to resolve the discrepancies per WAC 434-262-060, 070 and 100.

Rejection of a ballot that was returned in a return oath envelope, with the precinct number printed on the ballot not matching the precinct number printed on the return oath envelope. In this instance, the ballot returned was not in the same school district as the precinct number on the return oath envelope. Therefore, the Board determined that this ballot should not be counted, resulting in the precinct on the return oath envelope being one less than credited.

Resolution: This ballot was rejected by the Board. Official results will show one less (-1) on the totals for ballots cast.

The Board voted to accept three ballots returned from voters that were already credited for voting in an incorrect precinct. These voters were notified of the incorrect ballot format sent to them initially and asked that they vote and return the replacement ballot with the correct precinct. The Board cited that this error was not the voters' fault, rather administrative error and the ballots should be counted.

Resolution: These ballots were counted by the Board. Official results will show three more (+3) on the totals for ballots cast.
