
That the total number of active registered voters in all precincts was 44,930 and that the total number of votes cast in such precincts was 17,919.



MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION LEVY

Upon the expiration of the current maintenance and operation levy, shall the following taxes for purposes of operation and maintenance be levied in excess of all regular property tax levies, upon all taxable property within North Thurston School District No. 3 for the district's general fund:

2001	2002	\$3.52	\$14,990,000
2002	2003	\$3.41	\$15,250,000

as specified in resolution No. 577?

The levy issue would require 13,330 votes to validate and a 60% majority to pass. If less than 13,330 total votes, this issue would need 7,998 total yes votes to pass.
