How To Mark Your Ballot



Fill in the oval to the left of your desired response. Use a dark ink pen. Do not use a pencil or gel pen.



What To Do If You Make A Mistake

Do not erase any selection made in error. If you make a mistake, draw a line through the entire response.

If you wish to vote for another response, fill in the oval to the left of your chosen response.

More than one vote for the ballot measure will be an overvote, and no votes for that ballot measure will be counted. You do not have to vote on every measure.

Voters with visual impairments, cognitive or learning disabilities, who are illiterate, or have mobility impairments can use an AutoMARK to have their ballots read to them, magnify the print, and mark their ballots. These machines are available at the Thurston County Courthouse from April 7, 2010 - April 27, 2010, or by calling (360)786-5408, TTY (360)754-2933 to schedule an appointment.

Please do not cut or alter the shape or size of your ballot.

Return Your Ballot: Follow the instructions on the envelopes and the ballot. Remember to sign and date the voter's affidavit on the return envelope.
