**GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS**

The Board of Directors of Tenino School District No. 402 adopted Resolution No. 7:2003-2004, concerning a proposition to finance school construction and improvement. This proposition would authorize the District to construct and equip a new middle school (including a full-size gymnasium for District-wide use), convert existing Tenino Middle School into an elementary school and convert existing Tenino Elementary School into a community center for District and public use; issue no more than \$19,500,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within 20 years; and levy annual excess property taxes to repay the bonds, all as provided in Resolution No. 7:2003-2004.
