This April Special Election is only for those voters whose registered voter residence is within the City of Lacey or within Thurston County Fire Protection District No. 03 (Lacey).

Election Result Information

On Election Day, the Logic and Accuracy test will begin at 8:30 a.m. The first tabulation count will begin immediately afterward. A second count of ballots may occur later in the afternoon. Printouts of the first election results will be available Election Night shortly after 8:00 p.m.

Additional counts will be conducted daily beginning at 4:00 p.m. (weekends and holidays excluded) as required by law.

Updated results will be available each day after all processed ballots have been counted. Daily tabulation may be postponed if the Auditor’s Office is not in possession of at least 500 valid, processed ballots at the scheduled time.

The final certification will be May 12, at 4:30 p.m.

This annexation requires a simple majority to pass (50% +1) in both the City of Lacey, as well as in TCFPD No. 03 (Lacey).
