Thurston County Fire Protection District No. 5 Board of Commissioners adopted Resolution No. 18-522 concerning a proposition to merge into Fire Protection District No. 9. The Thurston County Fire Protection District No. 9 Board of Commissioners adopted Resolution No. 17-505 approving Fire Protection District No. 5's request to merge. The proposed merger, if approved, would create a single Fire Protection District No. 9.
