**Timberland Regional Library District
Levy Lid Lift**

The Timberland Regional Library Board of Trustees adopted Resolution No. 08-05 proposing to increase the District's regular property tax levy. This proposition would restore the District's regular property tax levy for maintenance and operations to a maximum of \$.50 per \$1,000 assessed valuation for collection in 2010 and to establish the newly approved maximum levy amount as the basis for calculating future property tax levies.
