GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS- \$35,490,000**

The Board of Directors of Centralia School District No. 401 passed Resolution #2004-5 concerning this proposition. This proposition authorizes the District to modernize, restore and expand Centralia High School, modernize and improve the facilities of Washington, Oakview and Jefferson Lincoln Elementary Schools, replace Fords Prairie Elementary School on the existing site, and make other capital improvements, to issue \$35,490,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within a maximum of 20 years, and levy property taxes annually, in addition to regular tax levies, to repay such bonds, all as provided in Resolution #2004-5.

Thurston County Regional Justice Center
Special Election - Proposition No. 1
GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS - \$88,000,000

The Board of County Commissioners of Thurston County adopted Resolution No. 13057 concerning a proposition to issue general obligation bonds for the acquisition, construction and equipping of a regional criminal justice center. This proposition would authorize the County to acquire, construct and equip a 640-bed jail and four nonjury courtrooms, improve seven courtrooms in the existing County courthouse, and renovate the County's existing jail, and issue general obligation bonds in the principal amount of \$88,000,000, maturing within a maximum of 25 years, and levy property taxes annually, in addition to regular tax levies, to repay such bonds.
