Special Election – Proposition No. 1
GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS

The Board of Fire Commissioners of Fire Protection District No. 1 adopted Resolution No. 2006-3 concerning a proposition to issue general obligation bonds. This proposition would authorize the District to construct and equip a new fire station and issue no more than \$3,500,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within 15 years payable from annual excess property tax levies upon all taxable property within the District, all as provided in Resolution No. 2006-3.
