Fire Protection Bonds - \$2,998,000

The Board of Fire Commissioners of Fire Protection District No. 11 adopted Resolution No. 2004-331 concerning a proposition to issue general obligation bonds. This proposition would authorize the District to acquire and equip new and upgrade existing emergency response vehicles, including a fire engine, water tender and rescue/aid vehicles, acquire real property and firefighting and other equipment, construct, remodel and equip new and existing fire stations and issue no more than \$2,998,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within 20 years payable from annual excess property tax levied upon all taxable property within the District, all as provided in Resolution No. 2004-331.

**Tanglewilde Parks and Recreation District

Maintenance and Operation Levy - \$95,400**

The Commissioners of Tanglewilde Parks and Recreation District adopted Resolution No. 2 concerning a proposition to levy property taxes. The proposition would authorize the District to levy property taxes in excess of all regular property tax levies at the approximate rate of \$1.05 per one thousand dollars of assessed value upon all taxable property within the District for collection in 2005 to provide a total of \$95,400 for purposes of operation and maintenance for the District's General Fund.
