

## 2020 Precinct Adjustments

### Overview

- Thurston County currently has 280 voting precincts
- In accordance with RCW 29A.16.040:
  - No changes may be made during the period starting fourteen days prior to the first day for candidates to file for the primary election
  - No precinct may exceed 1,500 active registered voters
- In accordance with RCW 29A.16.050:
  - Every voting precinct must be wholly within a single congressional district, a single legislative district, a single district of a county legislative authority, and, if applicable, a single city
  - Every voting precinct must be composed, as nearly as practicable, of contiguous and compact areas

### Proposed Results

- Proposed 2020 Precinct Count = 284
- Approximate Voters Affected = 6,000
- Voting Precincts Added = 4 (Hartwood South, Henness South, Lacey 54, Tumwater 33)
- Legal Descriptions Added = 4 (Hartwood South, Henness South, Lacey 54, Tumwater 33)
- Voting Precinct Names Changed = 2 (Hartwood changed to Hartwood North, Henness changed to Henness North)
- Precinct Boundary Adjustments = 4 (Hartwood, Henness, Lacey 42, Tumwater 32)
- Precinct Legal Descriptions Amended = 4 (Hartwood, Henness, Lacey 42, Tumwater 32))
- Commissioner Legal Descriptions Amended = 2 (amend to reflect 4 added precincts and 4 renamed precincts) No boundary change.
