CALL TO ORDER/ROLL CALL – Chair McPhee called the regular meeting of the Emergency Medical Services Council (EMSC) to order at 3:30 PM.

- I. **APPROVAL OF AGENDA – MSC** – The following changes were made to the agenda: 1) Add Tumwater Fire Regionalization Study to Old Business, Item C. (Moon/Oliva) move to approve the agenda as amended and this carried.
- II. **PUBLIC PARTICIPATION** – None
- III. **REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF MINUTES**
 - A. EMS COUNCIL – November 20, 2019 (Greenstein/Kirkbride) move to approve, and this carried. Colt and Perz abstained because they were not present at the November meeting.
 - B. OPERATIONS COMMITTEE – December 5, 2019 (informational only)
- IV. **COMMITTEE REPORTS**
 - A. **OPERATIONS COMMITTEE:** None
 - B. **WEST REGION:** Report was handed out.
 - C. **STAFF REPORT:** Staff report is included in the packet. Kurt highlighted on the following: All BLS AEDs are compatible with the new LP15; WREMS conference registration is now open.
 - D. **COMPREHENSIVE PLAN:** See Old Business, Item A.
- V. **OLD BUSINESS**
 - A. Comprehensive Plan – Kirkbride sent the draft plan to all EMSC members and their alternates, back in November, asking for comments, and since then he has received 2 reviews. The committee met and reviewed the comments and made edits to the plan. Greg Wright Vice-Chair of the Comprehensive Plan Committee presented the January 2020 Coordinating Draft version of the plan. Greg also presented some history and philosophy of the plan, changes made to the plan, and the steps moving forward. Comments are due back from the Council by February 7th. The plan will be brought to the February Operations Committee meeting for discussion, and the February EMSC meeting for action. Kurt offered staff's assistance to the EMSC members when they present to their Boards, Councils, or governing body.
 - B. MPD Contract – (Greenstein/Perz) move to recommend approval of the Olympia Emergency Services contract, for MPD services, and this carried. This will go before the BoCC on January 28th for their approval.
 - C. Tumwater Fire Regionalization Study – Hardin presented – In November 2018 Tumwater commissioned a consultant to do a regionalization study. The consultant looked at 6 fire agencies from inside Thurston County to see if it made sense for a recommendation to go further into a look at regionalization of those fire agencies. In November 2019 the consultant recommended, Olympia, Lacey, Tumwater and East Olympia, to form a planning committee for further study on the potential for a regional fire authority. On January 2, 2020, 3 of the 4 agencies met, along with Medic One to discuss process forward. It was recommended for the agencies to go back to their jurisdiction Councils and Commissioners, brief them on the status, and then determine if each jurisdiction would like to move forward. The deadline is mid-April.

VI. NEW BUSINESS

- A. Dr. Leonard Cobb Distinguished Alumni Award – Ben Miller-Todd acknowledged Cindy Hambly for receiving the Dr. Leonard Cobb Distinguished Alumni Award for her longevity in providing training for providers to improve cardiac arrest survival rates.
- B. Appoint Budget Committee – McPhee appointed the following Council members to the Budget Committee: Frank Kirkbride, Stan Moon, John Ricks, and Paul Perz.
- C. SWOT (Strength/Weakness/Opportunity/Threat) Analysis – WREMS sent a letter to the EMSC asking for the council to perform a SWOT analysis. Kurt proposes that staff do a draft SWOT analysis and present it in February to the council for consideration. There were no objections by EMSC members to this suggestion.
- D. 2020 Ambulance Applications – (Hambly/Ricks) move to approve Olympic and AMR Ambulance applications, and this carried.
- E. Medic One Fund Balance – Staff will present an analysis of the 2019 budget at the March EMSC meeting. This will include projections for the levy restoration.

VIII. GOOD OF THE ORDER – 1) Dr. Fay said Dr. Fell sent her an email about the EMS problems in Rhode Island. She will send this to the EMSC Chair and staff. 2) Staff sent a letter to the WREMS Council regarding QI process in Thurston County. This was handed out to the EMSC.

EMS COUNCIL STAFF REPORT FOR 2/19/2020

ALS Update:

- The BAT II (Business Applications Technician II...aka Scott's assistant) has posted to the NeoGov website. The posting will be continuously posted until filled.
- ALS LIFEPAK 15 cardiac monitors were deployed 2/11/2020 to all Medic Units.
- The MSOs and ALS Program Manager are looking to do site visits to paramedic schools in WA and OR this coming Spring 2020.
- Two Thurston County EMTs are currently in school at Tacoma Community College's Paramedic Program and are set to graduate early this summer.

BLS Update:

- 35 Applications for the Spring EMT Class have been received. All applicants will be allowed to participate in the Pre-requisite Class on February 22nd. Test results from that day will determine who will be accepted to the EMT Course.
- OTEP Classes have begun for 2020. All online courses will be released by the end of March.
- Reminder of WREMS Conference at Ocean Shores March 27-29, 2020.
- February 12th will mark the second CPR/AED Training session for the Sherriff's Office. Thurston County Sherriff patrol cars are carrying AEDs to help improve survival for cardiac arrest victims.
- This month, Medic One is working with Olympia Fire Department and West Thurston Regional Fire Authority to honor 2 survivors of cardiac arrest, the citizens that performed CPR and the EMS Crews responding to these calls.

CPR Update:

- 6490 citizens in Thurston County have been trained in Hands Only CPR for 2019. 739 citizens have been trained as of February 11th, 2020. Thank you to all of our hard working staff and Instructors!
