



Sediment Process Alterations based on methods from Stanley et al. 2008

Delivery

- Surface erosion - Non-forest vegetation within 200' of streams, roads within 200' of aquatic ecosystems
- Mass wasting - Roads in high mass wasting hazard areas, non-forest vegetation in high mass wasting hazard areas
- In-channel erosion - Built Environment adjacent to unconfined channels

Movement

- Storage - Loss of depressional wetlands, dams



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
