
Guiding Growth Healthy Watersheds

What will the future look like in your watershed? There are policies we can put in place now that will help preserve water quality, habitat, and recreational opportunities in the decades to come.

URBAN

- Restore vegetation along stream banks and shorelines
- Reduce and slow the flow of untreated stormwater runoff into streams
- Build green roofs and rain gardens to capture and utilize rainwater
- Limit the amount of new impervious surfaces created by development by clustering homes
- Account for unavoidable ecological impacts to through in-lieu fee program
- 6 Concentrate development away from sensitive areas, like stream banks
- Convert surface parking to infill development with additional stormwater treatment
