1 2 None 3 4 Chair Simmons closed the public hearing at 7:05 p.m. 5 6 Mr. Medrud gave background information on the Tumwater UGA Joint. No public 7 comments were received. There were questions by the Planning Commission which Mr. 8 Medrud and Ms. Davis answered. A discussion ensued around the proposed motion and 9 concerns for Thurston County adopting a section of the proposed plan recommending 10 amendments to the Thurston County Code. It was agreed that each Planning Commission 11 would make their own motion, instead of one motion combined. Both recommendations will be presented to the Tumwater City Council and both will be included in their 12 discussions. Their recommendation will then be forwarded to the Board of County 13 14 Commissioners. 15 16 For Thurston County, Chair Simmons read a draft motion to amend the Tumwater Joint 17 Plan, including six separate land use and zoning amendments and to approve 18 amendments to the Thurston County Code, Titles 20 and 22 to amend regulations to the 19 Airport Hazard Overlay in the rural county and the Tumwater Urban Growth Area, and 20 to repeal Chapter 22.21 – 'Commercial Development' and Chapter 22.28 – 'Business 21 Park'. 22 23 MOTION: Commissioner Nelson moved to recommend approval of the draft motion as read by Chair Simmons, Commissioner Fleisher seconded. 24 25 26 MOTION: Commissioner Nelson moved to amend the motion as read by Chair Simmons by striking section 11.1.6 "Recommended Amendments to the Thurston 27 28 County Code". Commissioner Casino seconded. Motion to amend carried 29 unanimously. 30 31 Chair Simmons called the vote and the motion to recommend approval, as amended, 32 carried unanimously. 33 34 For Tumwater, MOTION: Commissioner Kirkpatrick moved to recommend 35 approval of the Tumwater Joint Plan, including six separate land use and zoning 36 amendments. Further move to approve amendments to the Thurston County Code, Titles 20 and 22 to amend regulations to the Airport Hazard Overlay in the rural 37 county and the Tumwater Urban Growth Area, and to repeal Chapter 22.21 – 38 'Commercial Development' and Chapter 22.28 – 'Business Park'. Commissioner 39 40 Sullivan seconded. Motion carried unanimously. 41 42 8:10 P.M.
