25		Mr. Medrud started the work session by offering Tumwater's contact information to
26		address the questions posed tonight by the citizens. He presented a Power Point to
27		review the update to the Joint Plan which is the document that covers the unincorporated
28		portion of the urban growth area in the city of Tumwater which is under the regulations
29		of Thurston County, which may be annexed into the city in the future. He provided past
30		information and maps showing the changes that have occurred, a summary of the
31		proposed update to the Joint Plan, and discuss implementation measures and next steps in
32 33		the process. The Joint Plan is a component of the Comp Plan for the city and county to help guide the future growth of this area. It was first adopted 25 years ago, and there have
33 34		been amendments along the way, and now we want to align the changes that have been
35		made in both Tumwater's and Thurston County's Comprehensive Plans. There was
36		questions and comments by the Planning Commissions which Mr. Medrud and Ms. Davis
37		answered.

39		Next steps in the process will be a follow up joint work session on this topic in the next
40		month, and then hold a joint public hearing thereafter. The goal is to have a final draft
41		presented to the Tumwater City Council by June in hopes they will have a
42		recommendation by mid-summer to be given to the Board of County Commissioners.

1		Thurston County Commissioners requested a follow up work session at their next regular
2		meeting as well.
