Item: Infectious Disease Surveillance and Control System for Public Health

Description: Thurston County Public Health and Social Services is part of a national "Notifiable Conditions Surveillance and Control System" that takes information on infectious disease cases from health providers, laboratories, and hospitals. Although effective in preventing most disease outbreaks, this system has vulnerabilities that will be reviewed.

Item: Controlling Influenza and Norovirus: Infectious Diseases of Current Concern
