ORDINANCE NO. H-4-2012

AN ORDINANCE amending the Sanitary Code for Thurston County, Article I, Appendix A, Sections II, IV(C)(4), and IV(D).

WHEREAS the Thurston County Board of Health (Board) is authorized pursuant to RCW 70.05.060(7) to establish fees for permits and services, provided the fees do not exceed the actual cost of providing the services; and

WHEREAS reorganization of the fee schedule for food establishment permits will simplify and clarify certain fees, and will better align the fees with the risk-based permit categories in Article II of the Sanitary Code ; and

WHEREAS revising the fees for OSS Professionals to separate the examination and certification fees will allow the health officer to accept testing performed by entities other than the County; and

WHEREAS reducing the Field Inspection Fee of on-site sewage system operational certificates will better reflect the cost of providing this service;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Thurston County Board of Health hereby ordains as follows:
