## **RESOLUTION NO. H-3-2011**

A RESOLUTION declaring that the connection of all residences, buildings and other properties discharging sewage within the Woodland Creek Estates and Covington subdivisions to the public sewer system is necessary to protect surface water, ground water, and to protect public health; ordering their connection to public sewer; ordering all on-site sewage systems in the Woodland Creek Estates and Covington subdivisions to be abandoned upon availability of public sewer connections in accordance with a schedule established by the Health Officer; and exempting the affected on-site sewage systems from certain requirements of Article IV, section 16.8.

WHEREAS, the Thurston County Board of Health and the Heath Officer adopt the following findings:

- 1. The Thurston County Board of Health is authorized pursuant to RCW 70.05.060 to enact such local rules and regulations as are necessary in order to preserve, promote and improve the public health and provide for the enforcement thereof.
- 2. Article IV, Appendix A, Section 5 of the Sanitary Code for Thurston County authorize the Board of Health to require the abandonment of on-site sewage systems (OSS) and the connection to public sewer in an area within the City of Lacey urban growth area where the sewer system has the capacity and the connection is permitted by the sewer utility; a groundwater or surface water pollution problem has been confirmed in excess of state or federal water quality action levels; the pollutant of concern is associated with OSS; the area is within the surface water drainage basin where the water quality problem exists; and the Health Officer determines the OSS are, more likely than not, significant contributors to the pollutant level based on the density, design or condition of the OSS and/or the geology where the OSS are located.
- 3. Woodland Creek Estates and Covington are subdivisions in northeast Thurston County that abut Woodland Creek within the Henderson Watershed Protection Area, an Area of Special Concern established by the Thurston County Board of Health, and within the surface water drainage basin for Woodland Creek.
- 4. The Henderson Watershed Protection Area was established because OSS were identified as a significant source of contamination contributing to the water pollution in Henderson Inlet and the presence of sewage from failing OSS in the waters of Henderson Inlet and its tributaries pose a serious risk to the public health.
- 5. Woodland Creek is the largest tributary to Henderson Inlet and has been shown in water quality studies initiated by the Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) to be one of the primary sources of fecal coliform bacteria pollution discharging to Henderson Inlet.
- 6. The Ecology studies confirm that fecal coliform levels in Woodland Creek violate state and federal water quality standards, resulting in mandates issued by Ecology, through the total maximum daily load (TMDL) process, to reduce fecal coliform bacteria pollution in Woodland Creek.

- 7. The Ecology TMDL study also attributed high nitrate-nitrogen values of Woodland Creek and the tributaries to localize groundwater contamination.
- 8. The presence of fecal coliform bacteria and elevated nitrate concentrations is an indicator of fecal waste contamination in water.
- 9. Henderson Inlet and Woodland Creek do not meet state or federal water quality standards resulting in their listing on the 303(d) list of impaired water bodies under the federal Clean Water Act.
- 10. After performing water quality monitoring studies in Woodland Creek, Ecology in 2006 and the Thurston County Public Health and Social Services Department in 2006 concluded that human sewage from OSS in the Woodland Creek Estates and Covington neighborhoods are contaminating Woodland Creek, and connecting these neighborhoods to a sewer system is needed to reduce pollution in Woodland Creek.
- 11. The primary type of OSS installed in the Woodland Creek Estates and Covington subdivisions are deep trench systems installed into a sand layer at depths up to ten feet. The deep trench systems were intended to dispose of sewage but provided very little treatment. The sand layer is part of the shallow groundwater aquifer that flows into Woodland Creek.
- 12. The Woodland Creek Estates community water system well became contaminated with nitrates in excess of the drinking water standard in 1997 and had to be abandoned and the residences connected to the City of Lacey public water system.
- 13. The fecal coliform contamination in Henderson Inlet indicates the presence of sewage that poses a public health threat requiring hundreds of acres of tidelands to be classified as either prohibited from or conditionally approved for shellfish harvesting.
- 14. The sewage contamination in Woodland Creek and Henderson Inlet threatens the public health and may make the water unsafe for recreational water contact.
- 15. In 2006, the consulting team of Brown and Caldwell and Pacific Groundwater Group estimated that the bacteria load from septic systems within sub-basin WL-17mod (Woodland Creek Estates area) is 2713 billion fecal coliform/year, and that the bacteria load would be reduced to an estimated 153 billion/year by converting septic systems to sewer.
- 16. The Health Officer has determined that OSS within Woodland Creek Estates and Covington subdivisions are significant contributors to the fecal coliform pollution in Woodland Creek.
- 17. Connecting the Woodland Creek Estates and Covington subdivisions to a public sewer system is necessary to reduce the contamination of Woodland Creek and Henderson Inlet and to protect surface water, ground water, and public health
- 18. The Woodland Creek Estates and Covington subdivisions are within the Lacey urban growth area of unincorporated Thurston County.

- 19. The Thurston County Sewerage General Plan, section IV(E)(2) provides that individual OSS should be required to connect to sewer in areas found to have a high degree of aquifer vulnerability and where OSS pose a water quality problem and sewers are a solution.
- 20. The Thurston County Comprehensive Plan, Capital Facilities Plan, as amended December 17, 2010, ranks the Woodland Creek Estates sanitary sewer project as the first priority for sewer/wastewater utility projects.
- 21. The City of Lacey has notified the County that Lacey is the designated sewer service provider for Woodland Creek Estates and Covington and Lacey will assume ownership, operation and maintenance of the sanitary sewer system for these subdivisions when it is constructed.
- 22. The City of Lacey sewer system has capacity and the City will permit the Woodland Creek Estates and Covington subdivisions to connect to its sewer utility.
- 23. Thurston County has obtained a grant from Ecology and other funding for the sewer design and construction to accommodate connection of all properties in the Woodland Creek Estates and Covington subdivisions to public sewer.
- 24. Upon construction of the sewer lines to accommodate connection of the Woodland Creek Estates and Covington subdivisions, all residences, buildings and other properties within these subdivisions discharging sewage should be connected to the public sewer system and the OSS should be abandoned.
- 25. Any property served by an OSS in the Woodland Creek or Covington subdivisions that is sold or transferred prior to connection to sewer should be required to report the transfer and, if it has no current operational certificate, obtain a professional inspection of the system, but should be exempted from the time of transfer fees and sewage tank pumping.
- 26. The Board of Health understands that the Thurston County Board of County Commissioners plans to take action to cap sewer connection charges at \$6,640.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE THURSTON COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH AND HEALTH OFFICER HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. It is necessary to connect all residences, buildings and other properties discharging sewage within the Woodland Creek Estates and Covington subdivisions to a public sewer system because of the demonstrated high degree of aquifer vulnerability in the area, to address the water pollution in Woodland Creek and Henderson Inlet shown to be caused by the on-site sewage systems (OSS) within these areas, and to protect surface water, ground water, and to protect public health.
- Section 2. All residences, buildings and other properties discharging sewage in the Woodland Creek Estates and Covington subdivisions shall be connected to public sewer upon availability of sewer connections, and all OSS shall be abandoned as set forth in Article IV, Appendix A, section 5 of the Sanitary Code for Thurston County, in accordance with a schedule established by the Health Officer.

- Section 3. The properties subject to the requirements of this Resolution are identified by parcel number in Attachment A, attached hereto.
- <u>Section 4.</u> The Health Officer shall require all new development and all structures that will produce sewage, located within properties identified in Attachment A to connect to sewer in accordance with Article IV, section 6.7 of the Sanitary Code for Thurston County.
- Section 5. The requirements of Article IV, section 16.8 shall not apply to properties subject to this Resolution. Instead, at time of property transfer, the owner of property served by an OSS is required to submit a completed time-of-transfer application to the health officer on the form provided and, if the OSS does not have a current operational certificate, have the OSS inspected by an OSS professional and file the completed inspection report with the health officer. The OSS shall be exempt from the time of transfer fee.
  - <u>Section 6</u>. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

Section 7. Severability. If any provision of this Resolution or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, in whole or in part, for any reason, the remainder of this resolution or the application of the provision to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected.
