CALL TO ORDER/ROLL CALL – Chair Moon called the regular meeting of the Emergency Medical Services Council (EMSC) to order at 3:30 PM.

- I. APPROVAL OF AGENDA MSC Chair Moon made a recommendation to move New Business, Item A (Concierge Care Advisors) to Public Participation. (Ricks/Kirkbride) move to approve the agenda as amended, and this carried.
- II. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION Alessandra Ramirez and Cara Abubakar with Concierge Care Advisors provided a summary of what Concierge Care provides. Concierge Care is a senior care and transitions company partnering with hospitals, skilled nursing facilities, clinics, physicians, etc. for referrals on seniors who are needing a transition from home to assisted living. The council recommended Alessandra to reach out to the Fire Chiefs Association, Fire Commissioners Association, Senior Services of South Sound, and large retirement communities in the area (Panorama, Jubilee, etc.). III. REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF MINUTES

- A. EMS COUNCIL September 15, 2021 (October meeting was cancelled) (Kirkbride/Ricks) move to approve the minutes, and this carried.
- B. OPERATIONS COMMITTEE October 7, 2021, November 4, 2021 (informational only)

IV. COMMITTEE REPORTS

- A. OPERATIONS COMMITTEE: VanCamp reported: 1) Medic One has been struggling with filling Instructor and Evaluator positions for EMT classes. TAC's recommended plan to Ops is to rely more heavily on individual agencies for instructors and lead instructors. 2) There was continued discussion on transport issues, which is on today's EMSC meeting agenda. 3) There was discussion about communications and relations between LE and EMS, and the sharing of intelligence. LE has been invited to the December Fire Chief's Association meeting for further discussion. 4) EMS calls to the assisted living facilities is on today's EMSC meeting agenda. 5) There is a planned MCI drill regarding Amtrack since it is now being moved from the Point Defiance route to the new route through Tacoma. This will most likely be a table-top exercise and will focus on the needs and capabilities of Thurston County. 6) The TRU committee was meeting weekly for discussion on the transport issues. Staffing the HPU and PSPH breezeway, as well as private ambulance companies staffing up, has improved the transport delay issue. The issue still exists; however, it is less critical, therefore TRU will go back to meeting monthly. 7) 2022 ambulance license applications will be reviewed at the December Ops meeting, acted on at the January Ops meeting and presented to the EMSC in January.
- B. **WEST REGION**: Perz reported: A couple of months ago a committee was appointed to review vacancies on the WREMS council. The committee discussed bringing on 6 more individuals (surgeon, emergency room nurse, elected official, OPD rep, emergency management rep, and a dispatch rep), making representation as broad as possible. The next WREMS meeting is December 1st.
- C. STAFF REPORT: Staff report is available on the website. Thurston County | Medic One | Committee Meeting

<u>Information (thurstoncountywa.gov).</u> Hardin pointed out the final OTEP topic for 2021 is MCI and was released on October 31st. This will be an on-line only class for EMTs.

V. OLD BUSINESS

- A. <u>Governor's Vaccine Mandate</u> Hardin reported: There was minimal impact to Thurston County EMS agencies, and it was not significant enough to request additional resources from the state. There has been discussion about the Governor requiring companies with 50 or more employees to be vaccinated.
- B. <u>Long Term Care Facility EMS Responses</u> VanCamp reported: This was discussed at the Ops and Fire Chief's meeting, and those agencies affected by this are already addressing it. Chair Moon asked VanCamp to ask Ops if there is anything the EMSC can do to help support a county wide policy.
- C. <u>Hospital Entry/Ambulance Delays/HPU</u> The HPU is mostly staffed by agency personnel, however the Ops committee (thru TRU) is looking at Medic One's role with the HPU and identifying how to keep Medic One from being in an operational capacity. Clem reported staffing improvements with Olympic Ambulance.

VI. NEW BUSINESS

- A. <u>2022–2023 Budget Update</u> Hardin said the 2022-2023 budget, recommended by the EMSC, is proceeding along and final action by the BoCC is scheduled for December 17th.
- B. <u>3rd Qtr 2021 Budget vs. Actual</u> This was presented by Joy Miller, which shows an overall used rate of 66%. Hardin reminded the council that because we are in the last quarter, we will have 4 months of billing because December bills will be paid in January, which is the 13th month. It was also pointed out that under BLS Salaries/Benefits, on the summary sheet, it says, "This decrease" and it should say "This increase".

- **VIII. GOOD OF THE ORDER** Chair Moon said due to an expected light agenda, the December EMSC meeting has been cancelled.

- **I. CALL TO ORDER/ROLL CALL** The meeting was called to order at 2:00.
- **II. APPROVAL OF AGENDA –MSC –** New Business, Item B, BLS Funds 2021, was added to the agenda. (Clem/Brooks) move to approve the agenda as amended, and this carried.
- **III. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION** None
- **IV.** REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF MINUTES
 - 1. Operations Committee November 4, 2021 (Flewelling/Brooks) move to approve and this carried.
 - 2. EMS Council November 17, 2021 (informational only)
- **V. COMMITTEE REPORTS** Chair VanCamp asked Committee Chairs to please provide a report to Sandra Bush at least one week in advance of the Operations Committee meeting.
 - A. West Region EMS Council Clem reported on the December 1, 2021 meeting: 1) The need to have an SEI workshop was discussed, and there should be one annually per the strategic plan. This has historically been part of the conference but will now need to be independent since there hasn't been a conference the past 2 years. 2) They are on pace with budget, with a surplus of \$7,236.43, which will be slated to be used to support the SEI workshop. 3) The Cadaver Lab was successful and ended with a net profit of \$8,833.92. Education was budgeted for a \$5,000 loss due to uncertainty with COVID-19 which caused a positive swing of \$13,833.92 in the budget. 4) The council granted a one-time payment of \$7,000 to support the Grays Harbor EMT class. Grays Harbor EMS lost their funding almost 2 years ago and they have been unable to get the legislation passed to restore it. 5) A request from Adventure Medics to upgrade their existing ALS license in Lewis County from interfacility only to a combination of interfacility and pre-hospital was approved.

B. Subcommittees

- 1. <u>Equipment Committee (EqC)</u> No meeting in November, the next meeting is in January.
- 2. <u>Mass Casualty Incident (MCI) Committee</u> Crimmins reported: The Active Shooter plan should be ready for Ops review in March.
- 3. <u>Training Advisory Committee (TAC)</u> Clem reported: There was no meeting in November due to scheduling conflicts. In lieu of the meeting, Drewry sent out draft job descriptions for the updated expectations of evaluators and the new agency lead positions. Each committee member was asked to review and comment on these, and to come to the next meeting with the name of the individual who will be the agency lead. Next meeting is scheduled for December 16th.
- 4. <u>Transportation Resource Utilization Committee (TRU) / Hospital Diversion</u> Brooks reported: The meetings have moved back to the monthly model, the second Thursday of each month. Ongoing activities are the utilization of the Thurston County Mobe to give the 3 day rolling totals of available BLS transport census. Miller-Todd said the December 9th meeting will have discussion about whether we will continue the HPU indefinitely, or something different. A recommendation will come to Ops at the January meeting.
- ePCR Committee Miller-Todd reported: Adam Phinney is the new Chair and Russ Barstow is the new Vice-Chair.
 December 15th is the next meeting (the committee meets the third Wednesday, every other month, on even months).

VI. OLD BUSINESS

A. <u>EMS Council Action Report</u> – VanCamp reported: 1) Governor's vaccine mandate and deadline was discussed. 2) Long Term Care Facility Response – this is being addressed so there is no need for a committee. 3) PSPH entry way

staffing was discussed. 4) The council was updated on the 2022/2023 budget, and the 2021 budget vs. actuals was presented. 5) The December EMSC meeting was cancelled.

B. <u>Transport Issues</u> – Hardin reported: The HPU will be staffed through December 31st. The TRU committee is discussing whether there will be a need for the HPU after January 1, 2022 and they will present a report to Ops in January, and Ops will present to the EMSC in January.

VII. NEW BUSINESS

- A. 2022 Ambulance License Applications 2022 ambulance applications were included in the meeting packet for AMR, Olympic Ambulance and Falck Ambulance. Brooks asked if staff could provide prior year rates at the next annual review of applications. Brooks asked about the Falck application because it only shows one vehicle, and Scott Jones with Falck replied that they have reserves. Chair VanCamp asked committee members to email Sandra Bush with questions on the applications, and at the January Ops meeting, the committee will make a recommendation to the EMSC.
- B. <u>BLS Funds 2021</u> Hardin reminded agency reps that the BLS contract stipulates BLS supply orders can only be made through November 30th, and supplies/equipment must be received by December 31st. The November 30th deadline does not apply to inventory orders from OIQ, only direct purchase items.

I. CALL TO ORDER/ROLL CALL – The meeting was called to order at 2:00.

II. APPROVAL OF AGENDA –MSC – Old Business, Item A (EMSC Report) removed; New Business, Item C, Appoint Nominations Committee, Item D, Advisory Committee Recruitment, Item E, Medic One Staff Temporary Assignments, was added to the agenda. (Clem/DeHan) move to approve the agenda as amended, and this carried.

III. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION – Karen Weiss announced Ciaran Keogh as the new rep on Ops for the Paramedic Association. Alternate name is pending.

IV. REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF MINUTES

V. COMMITTEE REPORTS

- A. West Region EMS Council See December Ops meeting minutes for the December 1st WREMS meeting report.
- B. Subcommittees
 - 1. Equipment Committee (EqC) No report.
 - 2. <u>Mass Casualty Incident (MCI) Committee</u> No report.
 - 3. <u>Training Advisory Committee (TAC)</u> Clem reported: 1) The final draft job description for the lead evaluator and individual agency lead evaluators will be reviewed at the next TAC meeting and then presented to Ops. 2) There is progress on scheduling the evaluator workshops and moving forward trying to plan out OTEP and evaluator status on the new model.
 - 4. <u>Transportation Resource Utilization Committee (TRU) / Hospital Diversion</u> Brooks reported: We are in the middle of a continued crisis level for both transport and receiving facility capacity. The HPU has been staffed this week because private ambulance companies are impacted by their own staffing challenges. There has been some level of success for HPU staffing but there continues to be challenges with overall BLS transport availability. There are also turnaround time challenges at the hospitals due to record high volumes through the emergency departments. Clem added that Olympic is being hit hard with COVID, however they are working at bringing some of the staff back over the next couple of days.
 - 5. <u>ePCR Committee</u> Miller-Todd reported: The committee will be discussing PCR/NO PCR at the February meeting. The committee meets every other even month on the third Wednesday. There will also be discussion on a couple of options going forward with what data points we want to collect in the ePCR because it was found that some of the changes made early on are actually lacking in some of the data questions.

VI. OLD BUSINESS

- A. <u>EMS Council Action Report</u> Council did not meet in December.
- B. <u>2022 Ambulance License Applications</u> (Kaleiwahea/Hurley) move to recommend approval of the 2022 ambulance business license applications for AMR, Olympic, and Falck. This recommendation will be presented to the EMS council at their January 19th meeting.

VII. NEW BUSINESS

A. <u>OIQ Inventory Orders – Tracking Cost</u> – Effective January 2022 Medic One will begin providing a report to agencies when supplies are picked up that will now include the cost of each item. This is an attempt to help agencies track their

- BLS supply fund usage throughout the month/year. An email will go out to agencies explaining this change, and comments/feedback is welcome.
- B. <u>HPU Recommendation from TRU</u> Miller-Todd reported: The TRU committee did not feel it was necessary to continue to staff up the HPU beyond the emergency declaration stated by the State. There is a request to the State about whether we can continue to use the ambulance license for the HPU in the event a local disaster or emergency was declared. (Hurley/Carson) recommend the HPU to be discontinued outside of a declared emergency, whether its local, regional or state, and there will be no pursuing of an ambulance license for Thurston County Medic One, outside of a declared emergency, and this carried.
- C. <u>Appoint Nominations Committee</u> The committee will consist of Kaleiwahea, Crimmins, and Clem, and Kaleiwahea will Chair. The nominations committee will report back to Ops in February and elections will take place in March.
- D. <u>Advisory Committee Recruitment</u> Fontanilla is asking for volunteers from providers that can serve on an advisory committee to develop new protocols based on best practices and to look at existing protocols to make sure they are in line with actual in-the-field practice. He is looking for no more than 2 providers from each agency, and meetings would be on a Thursday, once a month, at Medic One. Meetings could start as early as February, and as late as May, with a two-year commitment to start with. This will be an ad-hoc committee and an advisory to the MPD, not to Ops. Fontanilla will email a letter to all providers
- E. <u>Medic One Staff Temporary Assignments</u> Hardin has been placed at Public Health as an Acting Director until the County fills the Director position. Drewry provided a list of responsibilities that will be shared between her and Miller-Todd, during Hardin's absence. The absence is expected to be 3 6 months. Two highlighted responsibilities Drewry will staff the Ops meetings and Miller-Todd will staff the EMSC meetings.
- **VIII. GOOD OF THE ORDER** Brooks stated that due to flooding concerns from the Chehalis river, the ECC is standing up at a level II activation and they are working on ESF4 support.
