

## MEDIC ONE STAFF REPORT – JUNE 2022

### ALS Update:

- Medic One will be hosting another paramedic hiring process June 22<sup>nd</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup>.
- ALS contract negotiations are currently underway between the Medic One team and the contracting agencies team.

### BLS Update:

- Final Practical Evaluations were held for the EMT Course on Saturday June 4<sup>th</sup>, sixteen EMT Students have successfully completed the course. A Graduation Ceremony will be held on June 20<sup>th</sup> at SPSCC.
- Medic One is currently working on a candidate to fill BLS Program Manager Position
- OTEP
  - Training is completing the mentorship process for new Evaluator Candidates. As new Evaluators complete the process, they are submitted State DOH for approval.
  - Lead Evaluators are required to attend quarterly training sessions with Medic One Training Staff and MPD. Second quarter Lead Evaluator Meetings will be completed in June. Third quarter offerings will begin in July.
  - Part of OTEP this year is a BLS In-service with Dr. Fontanilla. These sessions will be offered live and via Zoom. The first was held on May 12<sup>th</sup> and was well attended. The second will be held on July 13<sup>th</sup>.

### CPR Update:

- As of June 6<sup>th</sup>, 2022, 1377 Thurston County Residents have completed Hands Only CPR Training. Our Training Team is meeting regularly to work on increasing in-person opportunities. Thank you to all of our Instructors and Fire Agencies for teaching and hosting these classes.

### IT Update:

- Medic One has started the purchasing of backlogged equipment orders. Supply-chain constraints continue to be an issue and are impacting delivery dates.
- Medic One has started the migration of cellular access contracts and fees from the Agencies to the Medic One budget as discussed at Medic One Operations and EMS Councils. Currently 25% completed and a work in progress.
