ALS Update:

- We are currently working on staffing the HPU Mondays and Fridays through the end of February. Extending the HPU past February will be reassessed by the TRU Committee. Medic One sincerely appreciates all of the staffing assistance throughout this process!
- EPCR Committee will meet on February 16th at 09:30am. We will be reopening the PCR/NO PCR MPD Policy, and are attempting to close gaps in DOA, MVC, and Lift Assist dispositions that do not have PCRs and are receiving coroner's and private resident medical records requests.
- TRU Committee will meet February 10th at 13:00. This committee has a Zoom only option at this point. We will revisit migrating to an in-person option at the next meeting.
- MOUs need to be signed for the Entryway EMT process at PSPH. Please do so ASAP so that we start up the process again going into Flu season!
- As a reminder; Physio-Control adult AED pads are under a shortage nationwide. Please do not discard adult AED pads that are expired less than 2 months.

BLS Update:

- Planning for EMT Course 2022-1 is in process. We are currently working with the SEIs to identify a lead and dates for each in-person class session.
- TAC has approved job descriptions for the new Evaluator Process, for recommendation to Operations Committee. A Lead Evaluator from each Department has been identified. Lead Evaluators will meet ahead of the Evaluator Workshop and will be assisting with the skills portion.
- The job description for a full-time SEI has been posted.
- OTEP
 - All Online courses have been released for all BLS Providers and Instructors.
 Practical skills will be evaluated throughout the year.
 - BLS Certifications are being processed for all 2022 recertifying personnel.
 - In 2022, Training will be working with Lexipol (online training platform) for County-wide implementation in 2023.
 - BLS Evaluator Workshops are scheduled for March 1st, 2nd, and 3rd for 2022. We may need to schedule a make-up workshop for those who cannot attend any of the March dates. Applications for the Workshop have been postponed to beginning of February.

CPR Update:

• As of January 24th 223 citizens have completed Hands Only CPR Classes in 2022. A total of 24 classes are scheduled for the month of January. Thank you to all of our Instructors, and Fire Agencies for teaching and hosting these classes.

IT Update:

• Medic One has started purchasing of backlogged equipment orders, supply-chain constraints continue to be an issue and are impacting delivery dates. Orders will be filled as equipment arrives at Medic One.
