2019-2020 Plan Progress

- 25 total strategies
- 33 SMART objectives in 2019-2020 Plan
 - 19 were completed
 - 9 dropped due to COVID-19/barriers
 - Continued work on other objectives



Revision of 2019-2020 Plan

- Informed by community input and discussions
 - Strategy discussion groups, Task Force meetings, and work group participation
 - 113 individuals & 46 agencies
- 26 strategies in proposed 2021-2022 Plan
 - 14 strategies carried over from 2019-2020 Plan
 - 12 proposed new strategies

Achievable	○ Appears feasible and within reach based on resources, personnel, cost and time.
Relevant	○ Connects to the goal and strategy in a meaningful way.
Time-Bound	○ Includes a time frame by which the objective will be accomplished.
