


Charted ALS administrations of Narcan from 1/1/2021 to 12/31/2021


#### **DEFINITIONS**


<u>Confirmed</u>: Patient confirmation, bystander confirmation, Narcan reversal. <u>Suspected</u>: Physical evidence, bystander information.

<u>Unknown:</u> Unknown cause DLOC, unknown cause cardiac arrest.









# PUBLIC NARCAN

- Narcan was administered by bystanders 29 times prior to ALS arrival.
- Law Enforcement administered Narcan 13 times prior to EMS.


\*BLS reports were not included, as ESO search criteria was based off of medication administration.

# EMS resuscitation attempted - with Narcan

## **CPR**

- 61 attempted resuscitations with ALS Narcan
- 31 attempted resuscitations with "Suspected" or "Confirmed" narcotic OD
- 11 Code 9 ("Suspected" or "Confirmed" narcotic OD)
- 20 ROSC ("Suspected" or "Confirmed" narcotic OD)

## CARES DATA 2021 (CARDIAC ARREST REGISTRY FOR ENHANCED SURVIVAL)



- 29% increase of Thurston County cardiac arrests from 2020 to 2021.
- 13 CA attributed to "overdose" as charted in 2020
- 22 "overdose" deaths in 2021.
- 40% increase in OD cardiac arrests between 2020 and 2021.

<sup>\*</sup> Per historical practice, EMS resuscitation is not entered into CARES data if patient had a pulse after first round of CPR, without any other interventions. The patient is assumed to have had a pulse that was initially undetectable, which explains the discrepancy between ESO and CARES resuscitation counts.
