2021-2022 SMART Objectives

- 31 total SMART Objectives
 - 2 Objectives completed as of March 2022
 - 29 Objectives currently in progress
 - 7 Objectives near completion

PREVENTION

- Distributed safe medication disposal location cards to over 50 sites, including pharmacies & medical providers
- Developing a social media campaign focused on substance use protective factors (encouraging communication & positive relationships)
- Collaborating with the MedProject to place new medication disposal dropboxes

TREATMENT

- Completed one SMART Objective
 - T1(a) Survey of local providers on topics of interest for the Medications for Opioid Use Disorder (MOUD)
Provider meeting
- Upcoming community panel on services which build relationships with justice involved individuals & connect to treatment
 - March 31st from 1 pm - 2:30 pm
- Coordinating education sessions regarding justice outreach, in-jail MOUD services, & continuum of care resources

OVERDOSE

- Completed one SMART Objective
 - O2(b) Provide education and naloxone kits to 10 businesses or organizations for use in the event of an overdose
- Developing an overdose education & response video in partnership with Thurston Community Media
- Working on creating a fentanyl specific resource on increased overdose risk & naloxone response

PREGNANT & PARENTING

- Actively distributing pregnancy resource cards within the community
 - Paired with pregnancy tests
- South Sound Breastfeeding Network working on fall conference regarding substance use & breast/chestfeeding
- Collaborating with State Opioid Response efforts to create a pregnant & parenting service provider list
