### INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT

This CONTRACT SUPPLEMENT is made and entered into between **THURSTON COUNTY**, a municipal corporation, with its principal offices at 2000 Lakeridge Drive S.W., Olympia, Washington 98502, hereinafter "**COUNTY**," and **CONFEDERATED TRIBE OF THE CHEHALIS RESERVATION**, a federally recognized Indian Tribe, hereinafter "**TRIBE**".

In consideration of the mutual benefits and covenants contained herein, the parties agree that their Agreement, numbered as Interlocal Agreement No. <u>034-2016-071</u> executed on <u>March 3, 2016</u>, shall be amended as follows:

- 1. All mention of Eagle One shall be expanded to include Eagle Four. Eagle Four is defined as that property held in trust by the US Government for the TRIBE bounded by US12, Elderberry St., 196<sup>th</sup> Ave., and Edinger Morris St. and includes parcel numbers 55702000101, 55702000100, 55702000201, and 55702000200 and shown on Exhibit 2 attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. The term "The Project" shall include Eagle One and Eagle Four.
- 2. Section 4. SPECIFIC OBLIGATIONS OF COUNTY: a) iv. Shall be amended to say "Submit a "Right-of-way Application" and all supporting documents required by federal regulations, including without limitation 29 C.F.R Part 129, for utility and road easements and right of way on "The Project" property......"
- 3. Except as expressly provided in this Contract Amendment, all other terms and conditions of the original Contract remain in full force and effect.


