**Public Comment:** Glen Schorno – Commented on farmers selling land for other use. Believes farmers should have the right to sell development right or it would be like double taxing the farmer. Believe Bill 1838 will be a disaster for Western Washington farmers as it will take valuable crop land with no touch buffers. Recommend more time to review the SMP.

Marcie Cleaver— Would like to see BOCC increase funding to conservation futures. With land prices increasing, this would allow the county to maintain larger farms.
