Zoom meeting was called to order at 7:00pm

Approval of Current Agenda – Motion to approve (Robert/Pat) -passed
Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes for January – Motion to approve (Robert/Pat) – passed

Committee Items Discussed:

- 1. Farmer Member Candidate Meet and Greet: Chair stated Applicant Glenn Schorno who would be late to the meeting and relayed information to the Ag Committee. Applicant Chris Doelman introduced himself to the group and discussed expertise he would bring to the committee and property being rezoned.
- **2.** Executive Session: Ag Committee met separately for 20 minutes to discuss personnel issues no decisions were made at that time.

Motion to forward a recommendation to the BoCC to elect Glenn Schorno as the farmer member (Jake/Tom) – passed (w/1 opposed, 1 abstention)

Motion to amend the previous motion as a secret ballot (Pat/Robert) – motion failed to pass

Motion to send a letter to the BoCC recommending Chris Doelman be elected as a farmer member (Joe/Tom) – motion failed to pass.

- **3. Shoreline Master Plan (SMP) Review** (Andrew Deffobis, CPED): Discussed development standards, and what constitutes abandonment of agricultural activities. Presentation provided informative links.
- **4. Election of Vice Chair:** Motion to conduct a vote during open session (Joe/Pat) passed.

Motion to elect Jake Yancey as Vice Chair (Joe/Tom) - passed.

Gigi agreed to continue as the scribe, will notify Chair when unavailable.

- **5. By Laws Proposed Update:** Robert discussed proposed procedural change within the bylaws to guide meeting procedures. Bylaws will be sent out for review again to the Ag Committee prior to the next meeting.
- **6. Project Notifications:** All received via email and recommendation forwarded to BoCC Staff.
- 7. WSU Extension Update (Stephen Bramwell): additional information in chat log
 - a. Upcoming March 2, 2022, Grazing Association Webinar will provide an overview of the Rancher Stewardship Alliance.
 - b. Economic study with University of Idaho, balancing new reserves with habitat conservation, and easements. There are good economic impacts through support of the study.
 - c. Ag Grants are still open through the American Rescue Recover Grant for the year.
 - d. Farm business course has started and will be offered again.

- **9. Public Comment:** Glen Schorno House Bill 1838 caused a divide between the farmer and Native Americans, but Thurston County has a good relationship with our native partners and there is common interests and respect.
