Community Driven Review of Ag: Agriculture Zoning Update

Overview

In 2020, the Board of County Commissioners added a review of agricultural policies and programs to the docket. This project is docket item CPA-16.

One component of this project is a review and update of agricultural zoning in Thurston County.

What's Changing

The County is reviewing which lands are protected for current and future agricultural use. This change is based on underlying soils. Changes in zoning impact the uses allowed on a property, how many houses can be built, and more. A change in zoning does not require land be used for agriculture.

Quick Facts

- In 2019, Community requested this project to further protect farmland.
- The County was appealed in 2020 on which lands are protected for ag.
- A 2021 community survey told us land use policy is a top priority.
- Thurston County has diverse farmland and many small farms.
- Thurston County's farmland is at continued risk of being lost.
