Dear Thurston County Health Care Partners,

The Washington State Department of Health updated COVID-19 guidance for healthcare facilities including long-term care facilities. Currently, guidance for healthcare facilities in Washington State aligns with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention Interim Infection Prevention and Control Recommendations for Healthcare Personnel During the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) Pandemic.

The Washington State Department of Health has also issued a <u>SARS-CoV-2 Infection Prevention and Control in Health Care Settings Toolkit</u> with supplementary resources.

Please note that masking as part of source control in the healthcare setting continues to be recommended for everyone in healthcare facilities even when they do not have symptoms. Facilities can choose to continue to require masks or make them optional. Facilities with reported COVID-19 outbreaks will receive written guidance from Thurston County Public Health and Social Services outlining required and recommended infection control measures.
