Request For Proposal #23-02 Ballot Printing Services

Question 1:

Vendor1: Is this going to be on a roll or one off?

Elections: For clarification, are you referring to the ballot stock as being "on a roll or one off"?

- <u>Vendor1</u>: Yes. The bid indicates that the County will furnish 650,000 sheets. To me that means individual one up pieces of blank ballot stock. Just want to clarify that it's not on a roll.
- Elections: It can be either, as long as there is enough to furnish that amount of ballot stock.
- <u>Vendor1</u>: In the bid, it clearly states that the County will be furnishing the paper. That said, we need to know how it's being shipped? Individual or on a roll?
- Elections: Section IV (B)(3) Storage

The vendor will be prepared to receive and store 650,000 pieces of ballot stock (approximately a one year supply) for the county. If supply drops below 250,000 pieces, the vendor shall contact the county for additional supply to be delivered to the vendor.

Historically the vendor has furnished the paper stock for printing and our office works with the vendor to ensure enough stock is on hand.
