

## Host a low-waste event Borrow bins for free

Make recycling easier at your next event with our free recycling and garbage bins. We lend portable bins, signs, bags, and a how-to guide. Bins are available on a first come, first served basis.

### How does it work?

1. Decide how many bins you need.
2. Choose from one of five pickup locations.
3. Submit your request at least two weeks in advance.
4. Pick up the bins during regular business hours.
5. Return clean bins and any extra bags.
