bread, pasta, and rice

seafood and shells



meat and bones

YARD & PLANT WASTE



plants and flowers



lumber scraps
(untreated, unpainted, unstained - nails ok)



grass and branches



leaves

FOOD-SOILED PAPER



paper towels and napkins
(no bathroom waste)



coffee grounds, filters, and tea bags



GARBAGE

Missed pickup? Call your waste hauler.
Thurston County does not haul garbage or recycling.
