Minimum Qualifications:

All Positions (except Explorers):

- ♦ Minimum 18 years of age.
- ♦ Ability to volunteer 4 hrs. per week.
- ♦ Valid WA Driver's License.
- ♦ No Criminal History.
- ♦ Good Physical Health.

Explorers:

- ♦ Between 14 and 21 years of age.
- ♦ Good Conduct.
- ♦ Enrolled in school or earned diploma or GED.
- ♦ Minimum 2.0 GPA.
- ♦ Written permission of parent/legal guardian.
- ♦ Willingness to pay monthly dues.
- ♦ Attend Explorer Academy within one year.
