

<u>This decision is based on our finding that</u>: The Board overrules the Assessor's determination of value based on the evidence presented. Neither party participated in the hearing to offer testimony. The Petitioners purchased the subject property for \$415,000 on June 1, 2016. The Petitioners referred to a fee appraisal of June 1, 2016 for \$415,000, but a copy of the appraisal was not submitted to the Board for review. The Petitioners provided four comparable sales in support of their requested value. The Assessor provided a market-adjusted cost approach and six comparable sales in support of the current assessed value. The Board finds the purchase of the subject property to be the most compelling evidence of the market value as of January 1, 2016. The Board concludes that the Petitioners provided clear, cogent, and convincing evidence sufficient to overcome the Assessor's presumption of correctness and to warrant a reduction in the valuation. The Board adopts the Petitioners' requested value.
