The Assessor provided a market-adjusted cost approach and comparable sales to support the recommended value. The Board concludes that the Petitioners did not provide the preponderance of the evidence to warrant a further reduction in the valuation. The Board adopts the Assessor's recommended reduction in the valuation.
