Please keep us informed if there are any Inadvertent Discoveries of Archaeological Resources/Human Burials.

We would like the County to consider a mitigation plan that would include the addition of beach nourishment to the shoreline environment. The "retaining wall" appears to be a mesh fabric that may prevent the natural erosional processes that occur in a shoreline environment.
